Day 2 JOHANNESBURG – MADIKWE GAME RESERVE

After breakfast, you will make your own way on foot to the Johannesburg International Airport to check in for your Federal Air flight to Madikwe. Please check in by 8:30am.

Federal Air will transfer you from Johannesburg International Airport to their departure lounge a short distance away. From here, you can store any excess luggage if necessary, enjoy the lounge facilities and board the small aircraft for your flight.

LUGGAGE

All passengers traveling on Federal Airlines shuttle flights are entitled to one free piece of checked luggage and one small carry-on item. Due to the nature of the environment in which we operate, our aircraft are smaller than a typical airliner. As a result of this, we have small luggage holds which means that we have weight and size limitations.

The Federal Airlines luggage specifications are as follows:

Preferably soft (all-sides) luggage/duffle bags with ONE flat side. We offer soft-sided bags which can be purchased at our lounge at an additional cost. Maximum luggage weight (including photographic/filming equipment) is 20kg (in the hold); maximum luggage size per piece is 40cm wide x 30cm high x 60cm long.



Inter-camp air transfer times vary and may have up to 3 stops en route to their destination.

LUGGAGE

The luggage is limited to 1 x piece of luggage to a maximum of 15kgs per person – soft sided bags only – no wheels or frames or rigid sides. An additional piece of luggage to a maximum of 5kgs per person – hand luggage – is also allowed.

This is an air safety requirement and must be strictly adhered to. The aircraft used are small and specifically designed for bush conditions so adherence to weight limits is part of rigid enforcement of air safety.

Clients travelling with excess luggage may use in-house storage facilities or alternatively if travelling between Kasane & Maun we will courier at an additional charge.

Boasting one of the finest locations in the Moremi, Xakanaxa Camp (pronounced Ka-ka-na-ka) lies on a pretty stretch of the reed fringed banks of the Khwai River, in the beating heart of the Okavango. This is prime game viewing area. Set on one of the few permanent channels of the Okavango, this is one of the few camps able to offer boating year round- as well as superb game viewing on 4x4 game drives.



Xakanaxa Camp is a stylish but authentic camp with a homely atmosphere, it is an old favourite for many who return time and again to this special camp. The main buildings extend over the Khwai River on raised platforms to maximize the views over the surrounding lagoons and islands, there are plenty of comfortable areas and nooks to relax and soak up the beautiful surroundings. Constructed of local timber, reed and thatch Xakanaxa Camp comprises of an elegant lounge containing a small but comprehensive library, dining room, expansive sundeck, plunge pool and sala with day bed as well as a fire-deck set under giant Jackal berry trees.

The 12 rooms are true to the authentic safari experience being all canvas- though very comfortable with all the comforts you could wish- and each features a private deck with loungers and ensuite bathroom.





The reception lounge boasts a curio shop. The camp operates on generator power but at night all lighting is supplied by battery powered lamps, candles and paraffin lanterns, giving the camp an authentic African ambience.

Camp Xakanaxa has a genuinely friendly atmosphere with a strong sense of the traditional safari camps of oldit is an authentic camp with a real sense of place. The service is warm and welcoming, in a style for which Africa is so famous. A great number of the camp staff have been looking after guests at Xakanaxa for more than ten years and make every effort to make you feel at home.

Xugana Lagoon is widely accepted as being the most spectacular permanent water site in the entire Okavango Delta, overlooking a permanent deep water lagoon. Xugana Island Lodge is situated on a rich private concession and takes full advantage of this magnificent site offering a classic water safari experience.

Xugana Island Lodge lies on the beautiful and game rich Shinde concession in the eastern Okavango. The land is a maze of lagoons, channels and pretty palm islands. With access to large tracts of dry land it can offer very productive game viewing too. It is one of the very few camps able to offer water activates year round, as well as walking and game drives. Whatever the time of year- Xugana Island Camp offers a quintessential Okavango experience.

Xugana Island Lodge accommodates just 16 guests in 8 large raised reed and thatch lagoon facing chalets, with en-suite facilities and private viewing decks situated on the shaded fringe of the island. There is a strong sense of being a world away from everyday life here- it is a haven of peace and tranquillity- apart from the honking hippos!

An open boma and al fresco dining area overlooks the expanse of pristine water that makes up the permanent Delta. The lounge, bar and dining areas are set back under an Ebony and African Mangosteen tree canopy in open sided thatched structures, and the swimming pool, located within the mature gardens in the centre of the island, Xugana Island Lodge is a perfect place to relax.





Day 14 and 15 OKAVANGO DELTA

Exploring the Delta by motorboat or canoe (mokoro), combined with walking on surrounding islands in the concession, gives guests the chance to experience a classic Okavango Delta safari. Bird-watching opportunities at Xugana Island Lodge are outstanding, and fishing for bream and tiger fish is also offered as an activity at the lodge.
